

CONDITIONS-HARNEY COUNTY TRUCK PROPOSALS

1. Units offered under this advertisement shall be new 2004-2005 standard production models. Dealers Must state components under warranty and how long the warranty is valid.
A one year old (DEMO) may be considered, depending on how well it meets the minimum specifications.
2. Materials shall be of good commercial quality for the intended service and shall be produced by use of Current manufacturing processes. Materials shall be treated to resist rust, corrosion and wear.
3. The design of mechanical members shall be such that the stress imposed through normal shock loads at maximum engine torque shall not cause permanent deformation or undue wear on any member.
4. Proposer shall satisfy the purchasing official that he can supply at least the dealer items within a reasonable time.
5. Proposer must submit with the proposal the latest printed specifications and advertising literature on the unit they propose to furnish
6. Proposer shall furnish one service manual, one parts book, and one copy of the warranty with the machine offered. Proposer shall also supply at purchaser's request, proof of the date of manufacture of the machine offered.
7. The proposer shall list on a separate piece of paper, any **variations from, or exceptions to the conditions and specifications of this proposal**. This sheet shall be labeled ""exceptions to Proposal Conditions and Specifications." And shall be attached to the proposal.
8. The price or prices quoted shall include all transportation fully prepaid to the Harney County Road Department Yard located at 266 South Date Ave., Burns, Oregon 97720.
9. Purchaser desires delivery within 60 days of the award, proposer certifies delivery will be completed _____days from date of award.
10. Award will be made on a best-buy basis as determined by the Harney County Court. The quality of the articles to be supplied., their conformity to the specifications, their suitability to requirements, delivery terms and warranty clauses shall be taken into consideration.
11. The purchaser reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to waive any informality in the proposals, to accept in whole or in part such proposal as may be deemed in the best interest of the purchaser.
12. Harney County may elect to purchase the truck chassis from one supplier, and the service body from another supplier if it is in the best interest of the County.
